# About Arquideas...

Arquideas is a community of students and young professionals working in the world of architecture and design whose main objective is to showcase the talent and creativity of its young members, thereby bridging the gap between the academic and professional spheres of architecture and design.

Through its competitions, arquideas seeks to encourage its community to participate in current architectural debates, generating a selection of quality proposals that can provide solutions to the different challenges set forth in the contests.

Not only are participants given the opportunity to present their proposals to society, they also become familiar with how competitions work, a format that is increasingly employed to award the most attractive professional commissions on an international level.

Arquideas will exhibit the work presented in each competition on its website and publish the results in international architecture

journals, as well as on specialized websites and blogs, in order to disseminate the best proposals and provide publicity for their creators.

By disseminating the proposals presented in each competition, arquideas provides participants with an opportunity to improve their CV by winning one of the prizes or honorary mentions awarded by the prestigious Jury.





# The Competition...

The Amazon is a vast region located in the central northern part of South America comprised of the Amazon Basin rainforest.

The Amazon rainforest, considered one of the seven natural wonders of the world, is the largest rainforest on the planet. It is believed to cover 6 million km²distributed over eight different countries, of which the largest areas belong to Peru, Colombia and Brazil, followed by Bolivia, Ecuador, Guyana, Venezuela and Surinam. The Amazon is known as one of the regions with the greatest biodiversity in the world.

The high temperatures favour the development of thick and exuberant vegetation that is always green. The Amazon has been named the "Lungs of the Earth", based on the fact that it maintains a climatic equilibrium on the planet by continuously recyclingCO2intoO2.

The entire wet tropical flora of South America is found in the Amazon rainforest. There are innumerable species of plants that have yet to be classified, thousands of species of birds, countless amphibians and millions of insects.

In fact, 20% of the species of birds and plants on the planet can be found in the Amazon rainforest.

The Amazon rainforest grows around the Amazon River and its drainage basin. The Amazon River has the largest water flow and is the longest in the world, stretching for more than 6,800 km. The majority of its length follows a serpentine path through the jungle, creating a network of channels and many islands. The average depth of the Amazon is 50 meters and its width varies between 1.5 and 3 km.

Its drainage basin is also the largest in the planet.

It originates at the base of the Nevado Mismi mountain peak in Peru, at an altitude of about 5,170 m, crossing Colombia, and ends on the Brazilian coast.

The Amazon river system has more than one thousand major tributaries, 25 of which are more than 1,000 km long. The river system is comprised of more than 100,000 km of rivers that make up the Amazon Basin, upon which the jungle depends for its existence. About 50% of the precipitation in this region is produced by this forest system.

The main economic activities in the basin are based on the massive exportation of rubber plant and wood, which lead to a great deal of deforestation in the region, one of the greatest threats to the Amazon.



## Objective of the Competition

The objective of this competition for students and young professionals of Architecture and Design, named theNature Observatory of Amazonia (NOA), is to come up with ideas for the creation of a centre in which the Amazon ecosystem can be learned about and observed through intimate contact with nature.

The Nature Observatory of Amazonia (NOA) seeks to become an innovative reference for the dissemination of knowledge about the biological and cultural diversity of the natural environment of the Amazon, providing spaces for educational participation in environmental activities, as well as becoming an interesting stop on the tourism route along the Amazon River.

The project should establish a close dialogue with the landscape and natural surroundings of this unique region of the planet and be highly self-sufficient and sustainable.

The idea is to create a space which facilitates the relationship between its visitors and nature, a space which stimulates eco-tourists and invites the public to learn about the importance of taking care of the environment.

#### Location

The location of the Nature Observatory of Amazonia (NOA) is free, as long as it is linked to the Amazon River and the natural environment through which it flows.

The project can be freely developed along the Amazon River or any of its tributaries, with a fixed or itinerant structure, in a single body or in segregated elements, depending on the intentions of the proposal.

The Nature Observatory of Amazonia (NOA)can be linked to the river in many different ways, depending on the criteria put forth by the projects of each participant.

There are no pre-existing criteria for the floor area and so every team or participant is free to develop it according to their ideas.



## Program of uses

The possible uses of the Nature Observatory of Amazonia (NOA) are broad, but they should also always be focused on promoting understanding of and interaction with the biological diversity of its natural surroundings, as well as generating a point of interest to attract eco-tourism that offers a direct, entertaining and educational experience to its visitors.

Proposals can define the usages and capacity considered necessary for the estimated number of visitors and the IDEA of the project.

As a starting point the following usages are suggested:



- Bird, flora and fauna observatory
- Area of direct contact with nature
- Exposition and projection rooms
- Pier

Depending on the location chosen, the capacity and foreseeable time of stay in the installations and the type of experience that the project seeks to offer visitors, auxiliary usages can be added, such as restoration, open air activities, housing, point of departure or arrival of excursions, etc.



#### Call

This competition is open to international undergraduate and graduate students and recent graduate of architecture or related degrees, individually or in teams made up of a maximum of four members.

Recent graduate means that person graduated within the 2 years before the competition launching, this is, all graduated in 2012 or later.

This is an international call.

Teams will pay a single registration fee, regardless of the number of team members.

Each participant can only present one proposal, whether as an individual or part of a team.

This competition is closed to any person who participated in the elaboration of the competition or who has dependent personal or professional ties to the organization.

#### Queries

During the period indicated in the competition calendar that has been included in these Terms and Conditions, questions about this competition can be sent to competitions@arquideas.net.

Arquideas will respond to all of the questions posed during the established period and will publish answers to questions deemed to be of particular interest to all participants in order to improve the comprehension of the project and resolve doubts.

All the documentation needed to take part in the competition can be downloaded from the arquideas web site (www.arquideas.net) throughout the registration period.

#### Documents to be submitted

Each participating team will submit a single panel a din-A1 format in vertical disposition, where the ideas of the project take shape.

Each panel must have in the upper right corner the proposal identification code generated during the registration process. Any proposal that does not have a visible ID Code under the described conditions described shall be exempted from the selection process and annulled. (Example: NOA 0000)





The documentation included on the panel is free and always focused on the better understanding of the proposal by the Jury. It is recommended to present the following documentation given below as a minimum documentation for the understanding of the project:

- Settlement plan
- Representative plans and elevations
- Characteristic section
- Perspectives or digital images
- Small explanatory report

All texts on the proposal must be in English or Spanish.

All the information sent out of the single din-A1 panel will not be evaluated by the jury.

Two files of the proposal must be submitted:

- A \*.PDF file in a vertical din-A1 format (594x841 mm) with a recommended size of about 5 -15Mb.
- A \*.JPG version (lower resolution copy of the PDF) to be viewed in the website with a maximum size of 1500px wide. (Bigger JPG files will not be allowed)

The proposals should be uploaded through the webpage (www.arquideas.net) before the deadline of the competition shown on these Terms & Conditions.

The deadlines are untill 24:00hrs. (GMT+0:00 – London time). As it is an international competition, it is necessary to consider the time zone from which you participate.

## Criteria used to evaluate the proposals

The submitted projects will be evaluated by the Jury with the following considerations:

- The quality of the architectural proposal
- -The ability to clearly express the project concept
- The project location selection
- -The relationship between the proposal and the landscape
- Solutions provided for the proposed uses
- Sustainability and energy usage

#### **Prizes**
