DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

Development of an **Urban Project** referring to the area currently owned by the Company for Health Services n. 2 Isontina, preparatory to a redesign and reorganization process of the Gorizia's former Civil Hospital and recovery of the existing park.

The urban design, which is also the result of analysis regarding urban and territorial reality within which the Gorizia's former Civil Hospital park is placed, will provide directions for the future structure of the area and propose operant solutions for:

- the area's physical and morphological structure and nature;
- the public space definition meant as paved and green area in order to achieve a connective tissue capable of characterizing the sites, mixing different contents and connecting the places of the territory;
- the functional structure with particular reference to the contents, the interrelationships and the synergies with the territory and its networks;
- architectural definition of public and private buildings;
- architectural definition of connecting networks.

The scope extends for about 16 ha, corresponding to the property area of the Company for Health Isontina n.2. Any other areas not included within the scope will be considered only in cases of proven need, taking into account that such a choice would increase costs, both in monetary terms and time needed to carry out the works.

NATURE OF THE COMPETITION AND METHODS OF PARTICIPATION

The competition of ideas is open-ended and anonymous.

People specified in article. 90 of Legislative Decree n. 163, 2006 and s.m. and i., according to the Contest Regulation, shall be allowed to participate.

Entry registration is compulsory for participants.
